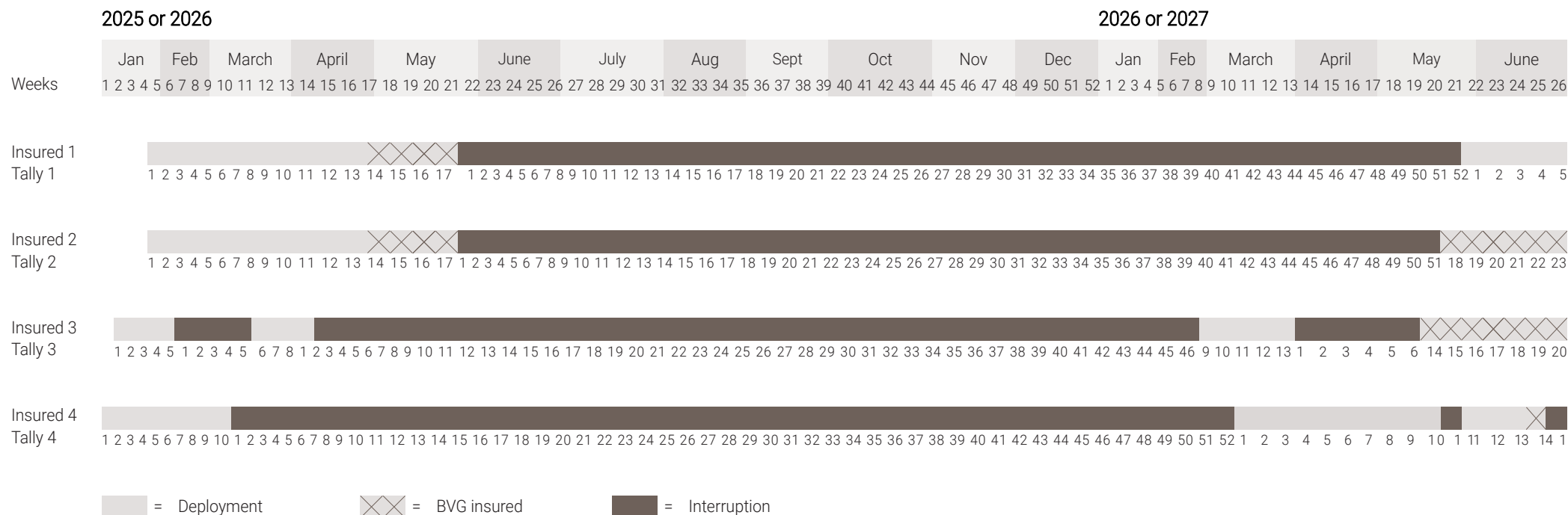


Example of registration with an interruption of 52 weeks



- Insured 1 registered after 13 weeks, then had interruption of 52 weeks and so is not registered again from 1st day but only after 13 weeks.
- Insured 2 registered after 13 weeks, then had interruption of 51 weeks (less than 52 weeks) and so is registered again from 1st day.
- Insured 3 had a lot of small missions but no interruption that lasted longer than 52 weeks. Thus he must be registered after 13 weeks.
- Insured 4 had an interruption after the first deployment that lasted longer than 52 weeks. Thus does not need to be registered from 1st day but only after 13 weeks.
